

What Does The City Census Do?

The City Census is required annually under the Provision of M.G.L. Chapter 51, Section 4. Certification of residency by the City Clerk is State mandated and required in order to maintain each individual's voting status, as well as for many convenient and necessary requirements to the general public, some of which are as follows:
